12:00 – Two Simple Braids to Decorate your Norse Garb

Alof will teach two simple braiding methods (Guilloche and Naalbinding Braid) which can be appliquéd onto Norse garb to give it a fancier and more unique look. Class is hands on.

12:00 – Norse Wire Weaving

Alfrik will teach basic wire weaving techniques. This class will be hands on. It will be useful to bring your own small pair of pliers and a piece of dowel (or other small smooth stick thing, like a knitting needle) because the teacher doesn't have enough to go around and will eliminate the need for sharing tools and waiting for your turn.
